**MANAGER'S REPORT-**Weeks gave his report on EMS for the month of February there were a total of 31 calls, 24 transports, and 7 refusals. Weeks reported for the month of March there were 20 total calls, 14 transports and 6 refusals. Weeks went on to report that with all of the rain that we have received we have had several roads that have washed out and needed repair. There were 2 roads that were completely washed out County Line Road and BonaParts Retreat Road. Weeks reported that the County has spent nearly \$46,000.00 to repair these roads and this cost

estimate has been turned over to Brad Taylor our EMA director to possibly receive funds for reimbursement for these damages.

**CDBG-** Weeks spoke with Paul Rakel about this project and it has been postponed due to the COVID-19. Weeks will be meeting with Mr. Rakel on April 20, 2020 to go over some items in the project.

**EMERGENCY SHELTER-** The school was opened on Sunday April 12, 2020 for a storm shelter. Weeks wanted to state how thankful he was to the school staff for opening the school and all of their assistance working with the County. Chairman Lewis asked County Clerk Carolyn Wilson to write a letter of thanks and have all the Commissioners and administrative staff sign it. Weeks will check with Rakel concerning any price changes on the CDBG project since it has been postponed.
