

NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

The Quitman County Board of Commission has tentatively adopted a 2026 millage rate which will require an increase in property tax by 11.00% percent.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on the tax increase to be held at the Quitman County Commission Office, 25 Old School Road, Georgetown, GA 39854, on July 30, 2026 at 9:30 a.m. EST.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at Quitman County Commission Office, 25 Old School Road, Georgetown, GA 39854, on July 30, 2026 at 6:00 p.m. EST and August 11, 2026 at 6:00 p.m.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 20.747 mills, an increase of 2.056 mills. Without this tentative increase, the millage rate will be no more than 18.691 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$104,622 is approximately \$86.04 and the proposed tax increase for non-homestead property with a fair market value of \$83,870 is approximately \$68.97.
