included a few tips throughout the template to help  
you get started.

What does a Poll Worker do?

A Poll Worker...

- ✓ Sets up and closes a polling place
- ✓ Helps voters understand their rights
- ✓ Protects ballots and voting equipment

A poll worker must...

- Be a citizen of the United States and a  
resident of that county.
- Be at least 16 years of age.
- Be able to read, write, and speak the English  
language.
- Not hold public office or be a candidate for  
public office.
- Be able to solve problems.
- Be an effective communicator.
- Not be an immediate relative of an elected  
official where the relative is a candidate.
